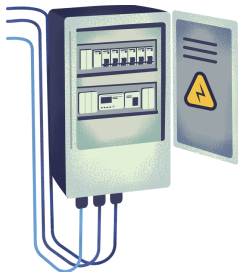

Electricity



- Pursue the exploration of local and regional gas
- Accelerate the electrification program for the remaining households that do not have access to electricity
- A mix of mixed grid and off grid solutions for electrification of households that do not have electricity.
- Increase free basic electricity for the poor to 100 KWh

Employment



- Redirect fiscal policy to promote self-development and to provide string incentives for citizens to take advantage of opportunities that emerge them into the mainstream economy.
- Target the development and sustainability of SMMEs by reducing the red tape they face.
- Revive the manufacturing sector and all other labour intensive industries

International Politics

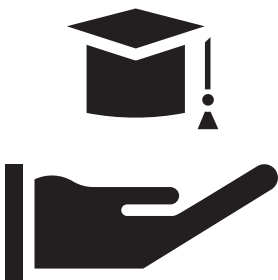


- Build relations that translate into actual contributions to South Africa's national priorities.
- Strengthen political, social and economic relations with all Afrikan countries for the advancement of freedom, peace, security and development
- Pursue greater economic integration within the Afrikan continent starting with the pursuit of a SADC wide customs union.

Pursue the democratisation of multilateral bodies by:

- Elimination of permanent and non-permanent membership of the Security Council and replacing it with biennial elections of members of the Security Council by the General Assembly
- Scrapping of the veto in the Security Council

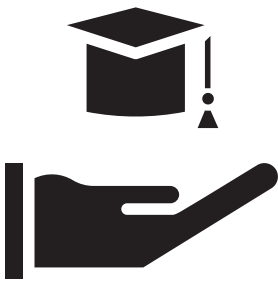
Education



- Prioritise education as a tool for the full realisation of our being as an economic necessity
- Provide free and compulsory education up to the first degree or post matric qualification
- Guarantee that every learner is taught in their mother at foundation phase.

Education



- Improve the status of teachers and the teaching profession.
- improve the status of FET colleges and encourage more students to enrol.
- Place special emphasis on vocational and technical education.
- Make education at Further Education and training Colleges free.
- Improve college and University infrastructure.

Health



- Institute universal health coverage through a single payer model where the government will pay for all medical services at the point of need.
- Make sure that there is a public healthcare facility within 5km of rural towns that is able to provide secondary healthcare.
- Provide for a special bursary scheme for the training of doctors, nurses and all healthcare professionals.

Crime
