Professionalise SAPS

- Rebuilding trust in SAPS through a focus on accountability through the improvement of police leadership and removal of corrupt and poor-performing members of SAPS
- Building capacity of SAPS at station level: We will recruit and train 120,000 new police officers to increase visible policing and boost specialised detective services at station level. Reversing the almost 10% decrease in police officers between 2012 and 2023 and bolster community-based services, leading to a more favourable police-to citizen ratio from 1:453 to 1:238
- ensure that resources and equipment, such as police vehicles and rape kits, are adequately funded, acquired and maintained for effective and efficient response from all SAPS stations.
- To combat crime effectively, we will usher in a new era of decentralised policing, bringing law enforcement closer to the communities they serve.
