- Promote micro, small and medium-sized enterprises (MSMEs) through access to opportunities, finance, mentorship programs, markets, and government tenders.
- Develop targeted skills training programs to address unemployment and equip citizens for the jobs of the future, with a focus on digital literacy and entrepreneurship.

Crime



- Institute religious and traditional courts within communities to selfregulate, involving traditional and religious leaders as the first level of intervention, to empower and involve the community in upholding the rule of law.
 - Provide counselling and support services for victims of crime and their families to facilitate the healing process.
- Professionalize and capacitate the police services in South Africa, through a comprehensive review, training and development of human capital, systems and equipment, culminating in effective and sufficient resource implementation.
- Strengthen border security to prevent illegal migration, human trafficking, and transnational crime.
- Take a tough stance on illegal land invasions, particularly on economically viable land parcels, while ensuring alternative housing for citizens, while deporting illegal immigrants not adding economic value, following due process.
- Ensure that appropriate punitive measures will fit the severity of the crime committed.
- Enhance intelligence-sharing and cooperation among law enforcement agencies, to combat organised crime and terrorism effectively.
