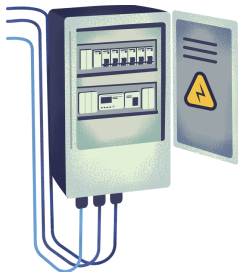

## Patriotic Alliance

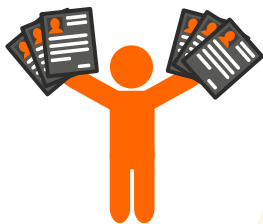


### Electricity

- Permanently end loadshedding.

### Employment

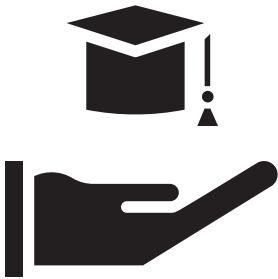


- Offering 100% youth employment through conscription.

## Education



- Teacher testing and remediation courses for those who are not performing well. They will either be sent back to university or reassigned to a job suited to their skills.
- Make tertiary education and even free for deserving students. Those who accept government help should not be allowed to emigrate.

## Health



- PA will put local communities in charge of improving the performance of public hospitals by creating community-controlled hospital boards.
- Explore public-private partnerships in order to raise the levels of public healthcare.
- 100% of HIV / TB infected citizens must have access to treatment.

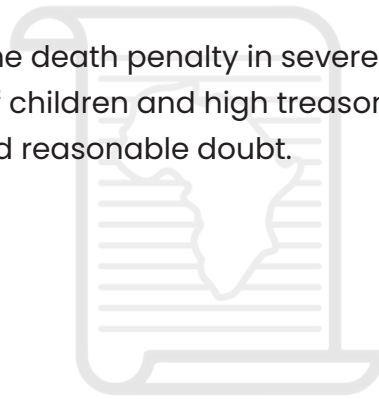


# Patriotic Alliance Manifesto Summary

## Crime



- The party will build a wall to protect its citizens against illegal migration
